

GUEST FACT SHEET

GETTING READY TO PARTY!

- This is a walking event, with some stairs required to reach the rooftops.
- Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes – women’s heels are not permitted on several of the decks of flat roof buildings.
- Because some time will be spent outdoors, plan accordingly for weather, including rain gear.
- If you have mobility issues or special dietary restrictions, please contact Jim Andrews at 815-558-5000. (We will offer accommodations to make this event special for all our guests!)

PARKING (see attached map)

- **WEST SIDE PARKING DECKS** – You may wish to use the deck across N. Main St. from the Coronado; at the southeast corner of the intersection of State and Wyman (just S of the Trust Bldg); or in the lot at State & Main, over the Convention & Visitors Bureau. Remember that most City decks now charge for parking.
- **WEST SIDE SURFACE LOTS & STREET PARKING** – These are very popular options. Two lots are located on the west side of Wyman St. on either side of Mulberry (across from the Library and the Morrissey Bldg.). **DO NOT PARK IN THE LOT NORTH OF THE LUTHER CENTER – your car WILL BE TOWED!**
- **EAST SITE LOTS & STREET PARKING** – *We cannot use the Brewhouse lot on the north side of the building as that is reserved for a wedding celebration scheduled that night.* We have permission from the Rockford Register Star to use their parking lots on Market Street (ending at the Jefferson St. bridge). We can also use the public parking in the lot south of the Rockford Park District Ice House on Madison St. or south of Walnut next to the Ingersoll Bldg (downtown sports complex).
- We encourage those groups ending at the Richardson or Trust Buildings to walk to the Brewhouse via the Jefferson St. Bridge pedestrian ‘under pass’ and those coming from the Register Star walk down Market Street to the Brewhouse.
- The RMTD trolley will run from 8:30 – 9:30 PM from the Register Star to the Brewhouse.
- An RMTD bus will run a loop starting at 9:30 PM from the Brewhouse to the parking lots on both sides of the river.

AT “RAISE THE ROOF”

- We begin at the Coronado Theater at 5:30 PM where each guest will register and receive a name badge
- You will also receive a “ticket” you may redeem for a complimentary drink at any beverage station.
- All 400 attendees will proceed to the Coronado auditorium where you will divide in smaller groups to tour three nearby historic buildings:
 - Trust Bldg. (202-206 W. State St.)
 - Richardson Bldg (112 N. Wyman) both located at the corner of State and Wyman Streets,
 - Rockford Register Star (99 E. State St), just across the State Street bridge from the other two
- Because of space and elevator limitations, we ask that you stay with your assigned group – if you see good friends in other groups, know that you will be back together at the conclusion (about 9 PM) at the Prairie Street Brewhouse!
- Guides and group leaders will help you get where you need to be. If you have questions, direct them to your Group Leader & Assistant Group Leaders who will walk with you.
- To assure you get to each tour stop as soon as possible, you may want to consider using the stairs.
